The original also has columns for “eaters” divided into (3) officers, (4) soldiers, (5) workers and families, and (6) prisoners; horses divided into (7) ridden, (8) artillery, and (9) transport; and vehicles divided into (20) wagons, (21) field kitchens, and (22) cars.
